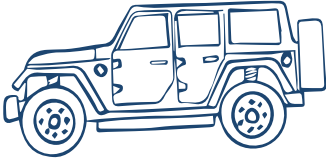

# DO



**ENCHANTED ROCK NATURAL STATE AREA** // If you haven't been, we believe this is a must see. Hike to the top of the rock, explore the caves, take the walking trails and enjoy the breathtaking views!

**TRADE DAYS** // Trade Days is an expansive flea market outside of Fredericksburg (290 East) that opens every 3rd weekend of the month. It's a popular event so we suggest going when it opens at 9am and on Friday if possible to avoid traffic jams and picked-over booths.

**FARMER'S MARKET** // The Fredericksburg Farmer's Market is a fun way to spend a Thursday evening. The wood-fired pizzas are a local favorite. You can also grab an iced coffee or a glass of wine and enjoy the live music and bustling activity. The spring/summer market runs May-August from 4pm-7pm and is located at Marktplatz. The fall market runs September-October from 4pm-7pm and is located on the Pioneer Museum campus on West Main St.

**NATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE PACIFIC WAR** // A world-class museum dedicated to telling the story of the many men and woman who gave their lives in the Pacific War. Visit [pacificwarmuseum.org](http://pacificwarmuseum.org) to learn about special exhibits and reenactments.

**LADY BIRD JOHNSON PARK** // Spend the day walking their nature trails, playing at one of their sports courts and enjoying a picnic by the water.

**WILDSEED FARMS** // Explore the nation's largest working wildflower farm. They also offer wine tasting, food sampling and a wide variety of plants as you walk through their grounds.

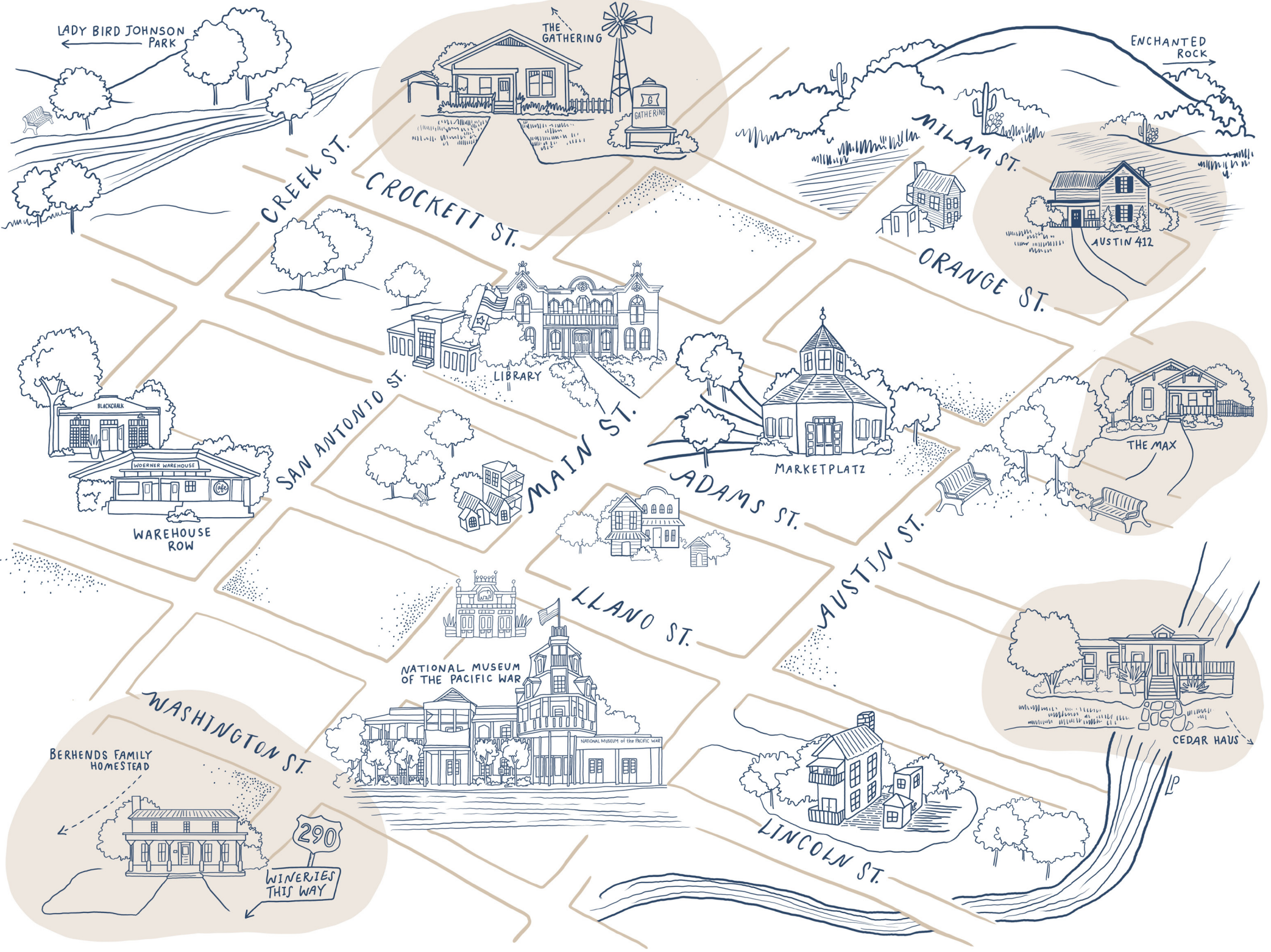
**CAROL HICKS BOLTON** // A warehouse full of European antiques arranged in whimsical vignettes. You will also find linen bedding and new furnishings.
